

AIRFREIGHT: As per previous updates, airfreight movements have been the most effected by Covid-19 restrictions. The situation is exceptionally volatile and airlines are retracting form most contract rates and all cargo is quoted on a case by case basis. We would like to share with you a recent comprehensive update on airlines services supplied by Air Menzies International.

Quote....

Singapore:

- Due to the volatile situation, there is multiple daily updates. Please visit their website for flight schedules and flight availability www.siacargo.com
- Rates are strictly on request and all shipments will be quote as a case to case basis.

Qantas:

- Flights are still on schedule.
- Effectively immediately Qantas will not accept any bookings for live animals
- Rates to PVG are still on request.
- Currently not accepting any bookings that feed onto an interline service such as POM, NAN, NOU or involve complex road feeder services.

Swiss:

- Currently operational to and from South Africa, they will only know within the next couple of days if the embargo will affect the JNB Route.
- The following lanes are cancelled and numerous flights within Europe are reduced:
 - China
 - Israel
 - Italy
 - India
 - USA – with the exception of ORD and EWR
 - NRT/KIX/HKG – reduced flight schedule
 - Trucking network continue as per schedule
- There might be some rate increases pending on final destination.
- USA - on this particular routes rates are strictly on request and will be quoted on case to case basis.

TAAG:

- All flights operational as normal, OPO flights has been cancelled.

Virgin:

- Currently still operating as usual however we will let you know once we have received any further information on flight cancellations.
- All tariffs will be suspended during this period, new pricing structures are being created during this period.

Air China:

- To date no restrictions in place, operating as per normal.
- Operating on days 1 and 5 from JNB

AirFrance/KLM:

- The following routes has been suspended until further notice:
 - BJS, PVG CTU, HGH, XMN, WUH, TPE, MNL, ICN, LIM, EZE, PTY, KWI, SSG, CCS
- HKG - AF Flights cancelled / KLM Reduced Capacity to 2 times a week
- The following routes are operational with reduced capacity
 - BAH, BOM, BLR, DEL, NRT, KIX

Airlink:

- Operating as per normal

Alitalia:

- Selective flight cancellations but do have some flight operations.

Saudi:

- Passenger flights has been cancelled till the end of the month, they are awaiting confirmation with regards to the freighter operation

Air Namibia:

- Operating as per normal

Air Zimbabwe:

- Operating as per normal

Air Austral:

- Operating as per normal

Cargolux:

- Flights are operating as per normal from JNB.
- USA and China rates are on request only

British Airways:

- Awaiting update from HQ, the USA will operate with restricted routes and schedules.
- Rates are strictly on request.
- LHR remain unrestricted until further notice.

SAA:

- Currently awaiting final update, once received we will advise same.

Air Seychelles:

- Currently no restrictions on their flights or routes.
- Please note the following flight cancellations – 23, 26 & 30 March'20 as well as 07, 14, 16, 18, 21 & 28 April'20

Emirates:

- Most routes are affected and its case by case as per all destinations.

Egyptair:

- Flights operating as per normal ex JNB.
- The following routes has been cancelled:
 - KSA Points, PEK, CAN, KWI, CMN, TUN, KRT, AMM, BAH, MCT, JUB, HKG & BKK

Rwandair:

- No flight cancellations as yet and are currently operating as per normal.

Delta:

- No schedule cancellations to and from JNB, currently due to capacity issues they are not accepting any bookings
- Following flight cancellations:
 - Bogota / Cartagena / Colombia / London / Dublin / Mumbai / Buenos Aires / Rome / Tel Aviv / Japan / Iran / China

EL AL:

- Currently no flight cancellation, schedule as per normal – departure from JNB on a day 1
- All rates are on a request basis and will be treated case by case.

LATAM:

- Currently no flight cancellation, schedule as per normal – departure from JNB on a day 1, 2, 5, 6 & 7
- All rates are on a request basis and will be treated case by case.

Qatar:

- Qatar Airways has extended their suspension of all passenger flights to mainland china (CTU, CKG, HGH, PVG, PEK, CAN).
- Temporary hold and schedule adjustments to the operation into Iran.
- Suspension of wide body flights (passenger service only) to/from Kuwait (KWI), effective 13 March 2020.

- The following services remain unaffected:

- To / from PVG and CAN, freighter operation normal
- To / from KWI, freighter operation normal (2x weekly freighters)
- To / from MXP freighter operation normal
- To / from HKG, freighter operation normal. Wide body flights continue as per current schedule except for QR816 which has been suspended until 23rd March 2020
- To / from ICN, wide body and Freighter operation. However demand is high and flights are constrained.

- Operational changes until further notice:

- Wide body service to Milan (MXP) cancelled until further notice.
- No further changes to FCO, this will continue to operate as already rescheduled;
- VCE and PSA services have already been suspended

- Currently South African operation continues to provide you with:

- Two flights daily ex Johannesburg
- 10 flights per week ex Cape Town
- 4 flights per week ex Durban
- Freighter Service ex Johannesburg on a day 4
- As well as QR Charter service for all your charter solutions

Cathay Pacific:

- Reduced flights ex JNB to 2 flights a week and cancellations around the world are specific to each country
- Information as well as rates needs to be request by shipment basis.

Turkish:

- Flight cancellations to the following destinations:
 - Italy (BLQ, BRI, NAP, CTA, FCO – MXP freighter operation only
 - JED, PEK, ULN, KWI, RUH
- Freighter operation to the following destinations:
 - CAN, PVG, HKG, RUH, KWI, TLV

- Flights ex JNB will be cancelled on the following dates:
 - 24 March'20
 - 22 & 28 April'20
 - 3, 7, 10, 12 & 15 May'20

- Rates are strictly on request basis

Etihad:

- Currently still operating to the US.
- All flights to KSA Airports has been cancelled until further notice.

Air Mauritius:

- All flights into China are still cancelled, still operational to all other destinations.

Ethiopian:

- Currently operating to the US, if any changes they will notify all.
- All rates into China are being upsold due to limited capacity.
- TLV flights are operational, transit time approximately 7 days

DHL:

- Currently no flight cancellations or schedule changes

Coyne:

- Currently no flight cancellations or schedule changes

Malawian Air:

- Currently no flight cancellations or schedule changes

LAM:

- Currently no flight cancellations or schedule changes

Kenya Airways:

- Currently no flight cancellations or schedule changes

Stabo:

- Currently no schedule changes.
- Freighter on 17th March has been cancelled, next available flight 23rd March.

Lufthansa:

- All passenger flights into the USA has been cancelled, only freighter flights are operational.
- Shipments to China and Italy are only on request basis.
