Please note that the ATDF have again advised that they are planning on shutting down the local trucking industry as a part of their continual protest against the hiring of foreign truck drivers.

SAPS has been advised and are working with the various industry bodies to ensure that disruptions are minimised but clients are asked to bear in mind the possibility of delays in the transporting of cargo during this time.
