Some progress has been made in providing clarification on the processes to be followed. Following a communication from SAAFF we note the following:

Essential Services

Please see attached draft list of services which are to be considered essential during the lock down.

If your business is classified as and Essential Service, attached is a suggested draft letter from SAAFF. This would need to be completed if any of your staff members are to travel outside of their residences for business purposes during this time. Note that this is only a suggestion by SAAFF and still has to comply with government requirements which at this point are still not clear.

Transnet

We await confirmation as to how containers will be moved during this time.

SARS

We continue to wait for information from SARS, once the meeting minutes are published we hope to be able to provide further clarity.

ACSA

Procedures are being put in place to determine how essential cargo will move from the airports and entry and exit will be controlled by the military.

Road Transport

We await the Government Gazette regarding the finalisation of this.
