Airfreight movements both inbound and outbound still remain volatile and exceptionally restrictive and limited with passenger aircraft still not operational. We remind you that a significant portion of airfreight cargo in normal conditions is moved on passenger aircraft. We are currently updating all airfreight flight schedules with all airlines for this week and will update you shortly but confirm that only freighter aircraft are moving and at present can confirm

Qatar - 3 x per week days 1,4,5 cut off before 15h00 daily hand in for export cargo

Ethiad - 2 x per week via Abu Dhabi

Saudi Cargo - 1 x per week bookings via JED

Turkish Air - Arrival day 4 (imports) and day 7 for (exports)

Egypt Air – schedules to be advised

MartinAir – Once again operational but schedules to be confirmed later today

Please note the following with regard to essential and non-essential cargo movement:

IMPORTS INTO SA:

- Essential cargo can be drawn from the airline and delivered to final destination on condition it meets all the regulations and is supported by all the right registration essential service provider certificates and documentation as published earlier
- Non-essential cargo can be drawn from the airline but may not be delivered to the consignee and has to be stored at a freight agents depot pending closure of the shutdown.

EXPORTS FROM SA

- Essential cargo may be booked and delivered to the airlines on condition they meet the criteria as stipulated for essential cargo and must be supported by all the necessary documentation. Please bear in mind the new regulations as circulated previously via newsflash and attached herein with regard to ITAC permits required for certain cargo.
- Non-essential cargo may not be booked nor delivered to the airline until lifting of the lockdown conditions.
